

Coronet Tournament Tournaments are open to all, eighteen years of age and older, who have lived in the Principality for at least a year, and who have at one time submitted a name and device to the College of Arms. A lord and lady may champion each other, so long as neither is championed by any another person. Letters of Intent must be sent to the Heir and Heiress and be received or postmarked no later than thirty days before the Coronet Tournament. Pennsic XXI Land Allotment

In order to facilitate the land allotment at Pennsic XXI, a Preliminary Land Request Process will be used. Participation in this system is voluntary, but most groups will find participation beneficial.

Group Sizes: Groups will be defined as SMALL (up to 30 people), MEDIUM (31 to 90 people), and LARGE (91 to 150 people). No groups larger than 150 people will be permitted.

Area per Person: Due to the limited size of the camping area at Cooper's Lake, and the expected attendance at Pennsic XXI, each person will be limited to 240 square feet. This allotment includes common areas and walkways.

Zoning: There will be separate areas set aside for SMALL, MEDIUM and LARGE groups. Note that the area zoned for LARGE and

Benefits to Participants: If everything goes as hoped, nearly the entire allocation process (including resolving conflicts) will be completed before the day of the Land Lottery, with most groups merely having to register their arrival. Only those groups which have not participated in the Preliminary Land Request will have to go through the usual Land Lottery; those groups will select their sites from the areas remaining. Also note that LARGE and ME-DIUM groups which did not participate may be required to break themselves into smaller groups at the Land Lottery.

Handicapped Campers: People with special needs should contact the Land Agent.

Deadline: In order to participate in the Preliminary Land Request Process, a representative of each group must request an information packet from the Pennsic Land Agent (address below), by mail, no later than April 1, 1992. 
